# Competition is starting

Tuesday is starting day S-day and Sunday is decision day D-day, the day to decide who is new European Champion. He will win the title here in Split aquatorium due to the fact that host for heavy weight olympic dinghy championship is YC Labud.

As Championship is open aside to big, Finn fellows from Europe in competition have entered strong fellows from north, South America and Australia.

However, respecting the reputation of out off Europe sailors favourites are those with European address because they are represented with ISAF first ranked Edward Wright, Croatian hope Ivan Kljaković-Gašpić and Slovenian Vasilij Žbogar.

Race Officer Peter Reggio held skipper's meeting and acknowledged competitors, 71 of them from 30 countries, with regatta details.

Daily two races scheduled until Sunday and medal race planned for Sunday. Depending on weather conditions tropes or windward – leeward course will be selected. This second looks to be more probable.

On Monday, very few Finns took opportunity to sail practice race, most of them decided to prepare their boats combining tuning and some rest in club café.

Tonci Antunovic of Race Committee has his own opinion of this saying that practice race

was more exercise for Race Committee then training for competitors. All in all small fleet sailed out about three o'clock p.m. and completed one race under 10 to 15 knots north easterly wind, known here as "bura". Sailors took a record of the race area and Jury test-

ed the equipment given by host on disposal, hopefully to their satisfaction.

Now seems everyone is ready and countdown to Tuesday noon has been triggered when beginning of big event is expected.

YC Labud has knowledge and experience in organizing Grade 1 events. Reference list includes Finn European 1997, Gold Cup 2006, Finn European 2010 when gold medal was taken by domestic sailor Ivan Kljakovic Gaspic nicknamed Bambi.

This year Croatian colours will be represented not only by Bambi but also by Milan Vujasinovic (YC Split), Nenad Bugarin and Josip Olujic (YC Labud) and Tudor Bilic (YC Trogir).
